

**Ambition 1- to be able to retell a narrative using ambitious vocabulary.**

- Listening to a range of fiction and non-fiction books.
- Using Talk for Writing techniques to support their development of vocabulary.
- Spot goes to school, Going on a bear hunt, Come on Daisy.

**Ambition 2- to be able to confidently take risks**

- Using tools and techniques (scissors/ pva glue ect) safely.
- Using cutters safely to manipulate materials (clay / playdough)
- To create pictures using a variety of materials and mediums.
- Revisiting and adjusting their work to improve on what they have already done.

**Ambition 3- to be a global green citizen**

- Enjoying spending time in the forest and showing care and concern for living creatures.
- Develop an understanding to look after the forest by ensuring they tidy up and look after the environment.

**Ambition 4- to develop independence and take care of themselves.**

- To explore the classroom and seeking to use resources during child initiated learning.
- Develop their fine motor skills further through daily “fiddly finger” activities.
- To be able to use the toilet and remember to wash their hands independently.
