## Show Me the Honey by Dr. Suess



Decorate digestive biscuits and turn them into bees!

A great way to illustrate pollination is to use Wotsits. The yellow 'pollen' left on fingers can be used to 'pollinate' the garden highlighting what a bee does for us.

Try a taste test, if you've got different types of honey in your cupboard. See what flavours you can identify. You may even have some local honey to try!



Make your own bees. You can use pom-poms, kitchen or toilet rolls. We used pasta shells as their bodies, coloured the shells with black markers and then used tissue paper for wings. Easy Peasy, Lemon Squeezy!



We used hexagon shapes to make a honeycomb. We also used bubble-wrap to print on paper. It was very effective.
