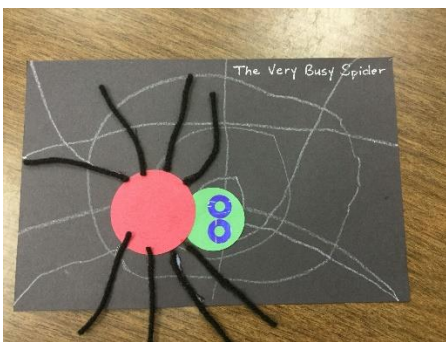


The Very Busy Spider by Eric Carle

Make your own spider using shapes.



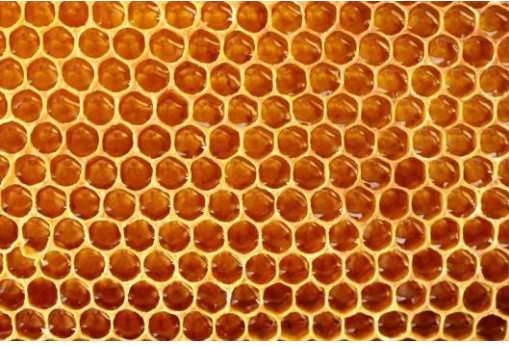
