

The stages of a human being's life cycle

Coming of age	Age when a person formally becomes an adult
Symbol	A mark or a sign that stands for something
Muslim	A person who follows the religion of Islam
Islam	The religion of Muslim people who believe there is one true God who is called Allah
Aquiqah ceremony	Ceremony for Muslim babies involving their hair being cut
Christian	A person who follows the religion of Christianity
Christianity	The religion followed by Christian people, who believe that Jesus is the son of God
Confirmation	Ceremony for a Christian child to publicly show they are ready to be a Christian and follow Jesus' teachings
Jewish	A person who follows the religion of Judaism
Judaism	The religion of Jewish people who follow the teachings in the Old Testament
Wedding	Ceremony held when two people publicly show their love for each other
Hindu	A person who follows the religion of Hinduism
Hinduism	The religion of Hindu people who believe the supreme God of Brahman is the creator of everything
Buddhist	A person who follows the religion of Buddhism
Buddhism	The religion of Buddhist people who follow the teachings of Buddha
Funeral	Ceremony held when someone dies
Body	Physical structure of a person including their flesh, bones and organs
Soul	Spiritual part of a person
Reincarnation	The belief that a person's soul can be reborn inside another body
