

### Key Knowledge

#### The stages of a human being's life cycle



### Key Vocabulary

<b>Coming of age</b>	Age when a person formally becomes an adult
<b>Symbol</b>	A mark or a sign that stands for something
<b>Muslim</b>	A person who follows the religion of Islam
<b>Islam</b>	The religion of Muslim people who believe there is one true God who is called Allah
<b>Aqiqah ceremony</b>	Ceremony for Muslim babies involving their hair being cut
<b>Christian</b>	A person who follows the religion of Christianity
<b>Christianity</b>	The religion followed by Christian people, who believe that Jesus is the son of God
<b>Confirmation</b>	Ceremony for a Christian child to publicly show they are ready to be a Christian and follow Jesus' teachings
<b>Jewish</b>	A person who follows the religion of Judaism
<b>Judaism</b>	The religion of Jewish people who follow the teachings in the Old Testament
<b>Wedding</b>	Ceremony held when two people publicly show their love for each other
<b>Hindu</b>	A person who follows the religion of Hinduism
<b>Hinduism</b>	The religion of Hindu people who believe the supreme God of Brahman is the creator of everything
<b>Buddhist</b>	A person who follows the religion of Buddhism
<b>Buddhism</b>	The religion of Buddhist people who follow the teachings of Buddha
<b>Funeral</b>	Ceremony held when someone dies
<b>Body</b>	Physical structure of a person including their flesh, bones and organs
<b>Soul</b>	Spiritual part of a person
<b>Reincarnation</b>	The belief that a person's soul can be reborn inside another body
