What are spreadsheets used for?

Storing and organising records about people e.g. names, ages, classes



Calculating information e.g. counting the number of something

$$15 + 12 = 27$$

Displaying charts



How do I select more than 1 cell at a time?

Click on one of the cells you want to select. Keep the mouse or your finger held down and drag it to cover all the cells you want selected.

How do I drag something from one cell to another?


Click on the last tab in the tool box.

Click on the totals tab, then choose the correct totalling arrow





Key Vocabulary

Block Graph

A graph that displays data with blocks.



Cell

A cell is one square on the spreadsheet. Cells can contain words, numbers, colours and symbols.

Data

A collection of information, collected by observing, asking questions or measuring things.

Spreadsheet

A spreadsheet is a tool that can be used to organise information.

Table

Tables are a neat way to display data. They have headings.

Name	Age	Favourite Food
Bob	11	Crisps
Claire	8	Bananas
Frank	9	Apples
Sarah	10	Pears

Spreadsheets are made up of vertical rows (going across) and horizontal columns (going up and down).
